Encyclopaedia will have new edition

with 4,580 entries




The Encyclopaedia of Conscientiology will have a new print and digital publication. With 4,580 entries, the 9th Edition will be launched on 21 December, the date of the 5-year anniversary of the International Association of Conscientiological Encyclopediology (Encyclossapiens), an institution created to coordinate this work as part of the groupal megaproexis.

With the participation of 701 verbetographers, beyond the proposer Waldo Vieira, the publication will have print and digital versions, composed of more than 23 thousand pages divided into 27 volumes, or tomes. "It will be the first print edition with all 2019 entries written by Professor Waldo," says Encyclossapiens coordinator, Dulce Daou.

The online version will allow users to download the entire edition or separate entries in pdf. In addition, it will also offer search capabilities by title, author, specialty and theme, possibilities introduced by volunteer Oswaldo Vernet, coordinating editor of the new edition.

Vernet was responsible for dismembering a giant file consisting of 2,630 entries, collected until mid-2013, prior to the founding of Encyclossapiens. A system of 'macros' was used by the volunteer, which also enabled the detection and correction of errors that pass unnoticed to 'the naked eye', which will



allow constant updating of the digital

The publication features entries in 612 specialties, demonstrating the expansion of conscientiology research areas. The first volume has 178 pages dedicated to editorial texts, a minibiography of the authors, a general index and introduction. "It as if they are instructions for use and a register for the future," explains coordinator of Encyclossapiens, Rosa Nader.

Due to the size and cost involved (about R\$ 5,000 each), the printed edition will initially have 10 bound copies, five of which will be destined for the Holocycle. Holotheca, Tertuliarium, Encyclossapiens and the National Library. The other five were funded by individuals. "The publication is part of the proposition of having a print version of the Encyclopaedia every 5 years," says Dulce.

The first prototype edition of the Encyclopaedia was published in 2006, it gathered 240 entries and had a print run of 1000 bound copies. In the same year, in a second edition, 400 copies were printed. In the third edition, the following year, the printed publication of 660 copies already contained 720 entries.

In other editions, from 2008 the publication circulated primarily on DVD, a version that will no longer be available. In total, the Encyclopaedia of Conscientiology has produced 3,712 copies, of which 1,600 are on DVD and the other 2,112 printed copies.

The coordinators of Encyclossapiens emphasise the co-authorship of more than seven hundred writers and invite you to the celebration that will mark the launch of the new edition and the 5th anniversary of Encyclossapiens, during the Tertulia on 21 December.

Meetings and reunions in Strasbourg

The Intermissivists' Meeting held in Strasbourg, France, from 9 to 11 of November, brought together 236 participants from 14 countries. More than 74% of them practitioners of the personal energy task, which favoured a harmonious environment in all the activities. "It was surprising to see the happiness of the participants, young and old intermissivists," commented Marcelo Brivilatti, of the event's organizing committee and a resident of Switzerland. Brivilatti said he was immensely grateful to those who came so far to contribute with their energies.

During the 3 days of the event, participants were able to participate in simultaneous round tables with volunteer English and Portuguese translators.

The parapsychic dynamics occurred in three stages, ending with a major energetic dynamic on Sunday morning over 3 different rooms.

The first 50 enrolees were offered a tour of the city and learned a little of its history, such as the old synagogue destroyed by the Germans in World War II; La Petite France, the historic neighbourhood in the west of Grand Île which is the old town centre with several monuments



listed as world heritage sites by UNESCO; such as Place Kléber; Place Gutenberg in tribute to Johannes Gutenberg (1398-1468), who lived in the city; The Cathedral of Notre Dame, more than 1000 years old; and ending with the European Parliament.

And synchronously, on this very day

11/11/2018, while at the meeting focussed on peace, universalism and multidimensionality, more than 70 world leaders celebrated the 100th anniversary of the end of World War I in Paris.

College of Dessomatology (ICD) celebrates 10 years

A varied program with the presentation of 4 entries, an Acoplamentarium, participation in the Intermissivists' Meeting in Strasbourg and the IIPC's Congress of Self-research, a Mentalsomatic Circle and the launching of books on desoma, among other activities, marked the anniversary of the first decade of the Invisible College of Desomatology (ICD).

Formed by researchers from various parts of the world interested in delving into the subject, ICD maintains the connection of its members through periodic online meetings. The research topics of the participants are chosen from a worksheet prepared by Professor Waldo Vieira and also guides the group in the elaboration of a treatise on desoma.

Currently, the College is made up of 25 members from Brazil, Germany, Portugal and USA. "During the 10 years of ICD's existence, the group has been strengthening its efforts to clarify the desoma as well as the number of participants," says coordinator Carmen Carvalho.

Among the highlights of the celebration is the release of two books. According to Carmen, one of the works on

dessoma is already in the final phase of publishing and should be published by Epigrafe by December 2018, and is entitled "Desoma. New Approaches to the Study of Death" (English translation of the Portuguese title). The other will compose a Holotheca collection with the title '50 Artefacts of Knowledge on the Desoma'. The publication will collate photos and stories related to objects related to desoma, such as wreaths of flowers in wakes and the black veil of widows.

The coordinator pointed out the group's work objectives for next year will be the publication of articles, preparation of a lecture and organization of an inperson and distance education courses on the desoma.

Congress closes IIPC celebrations

The III International Congress of Self-research, held by the International Institute of Projectiology and Conscientiology (IIPC), gathered 181 participants in Brasilia from November 15 to 18. The event officially marked the celebrations of 30 years of the institution, the first founded on the Consciential Paradigm.

The Congress had a record of 97 articles submitted to the evaluation team, of which 36 papers were selected to be presented in 5 conferences and 8 discussion tables. The annals containing the presentations totalled 414 pages, which required the publication of 2 volumes.

"Exposition of the articles took place in a very open-minded environment, with very open self-expositions, helping those present broaden their view of self-research and ratifying this as one of the strongest specialties in the IIPC. Participants remained present the entire time and left with a taste of 'I want more', and were motivated to write for the next congress," says IIPC general coordinator Felix Wong.

The actress Maria Paula, always remembered for her participation in the program 'Casseta e Planeta', participated in the event and launched her book 'Chronic Freedom'. Maria Paula has been attending activities at the IIPC Campus in Saquarema, attracted by the theme of pacification, which she has publicly adopted.

Among the activities, the course Projectiology and the Reurbex was launched, which will be held from November 15 to 17, 2019, in a partnership between IIPC and CEAEC, for the construction of the Institute's own headquarters. Participants were also able to tour the Federal Capital.




Editares
