Council approves 8 new epicons

The Council of Epicons approved in January the insertion of 8 new epicenters of consciousness. Those approved were submitted to a selection that had 50 candidates, including nominated names and those who nominated themselves for the position.

With the approvals, the Council of Epicons now has 48 members. The first meeting with the new formation took place on February 27. The insertion of the approved ones in the activities begins at the parapsychic dynamics and at the course Acoplamentarium, and, later, at courses of Extension in Projectiology and Conscientiology 2 (ECP2).

"The responsibility of being an epicon is great from the point of view of assistance, since the demand will be greater and the work will become more complex", evaluates the new epicon Rômulo Silva. The approval generated surprise, since Rômulo did not apply for the position. "I discovered when I had already been approved," he says, noting that he considers the indication the result of the work done during his volunteer work.

Rômulo is a volunteer at the International Institute of Conscientiology and Projectiology (IIPC) and was an ECP2 executive, a course he will teach. "I ended up being unemployed as a volunteer," he iokes.

The coordinator of the Consecutivus, Dayane Rossa, also learned of her appro-








val as epicon when the result of the selection was disclosed. Despite the surprise, she points out that for some time now she has taken on epicentrism. "When I started to make dynamics, I understood that I had to take this pattern of sustainability to day to day," he says. Interest was still declared at her first ECP2 in 2006 when the then first-time student asked the consciex what it took to be an epicon.

Most recently, in 2015, Dayane planned personal evolution since he met Conscientiology in the article 'Aggravation of autoparapsychism from intraconsciential renewals', published on Conscientia journal. "I divided the article in phases, considering all the activities developed in volunteering until then. While writing, I rea-



The selection process of the new epicenters lasted about two months. According to the Council member, Ernani Brito, the criteria for running for the position consider aspects such as the candidate's teaching experience, his performance in achievements and his constancy in volunteering. Also taken into the account are in-traconsciential aspects demonstrated by the nominees such as personal recycling, self-deintrusion, anti-conflictivity and groupality.



nal representation, since we will have more expressive responsibilities. New recycling will be necessary, things that you have allowed yourself and that may have to be rethought", says Rômulo. "There is pressure to get it right, as we end up being more example, people will watch more, they will pay more attention to my behavior," considers Dayane.

The next selection for new epicons will be opened in December of next year (2019) and will follow the conduct adopted by the Council today to approve a maximum of 10 new members each vear. "Whoever competed and did not enter. is not excluded. It can be indicated or selfreferenced in the next selection", says Ernani Brito.

A 6 hand's work at the academie's disposal

On Saturday, February 9, Ectolab released the work Ectoplasm - a Contemporary Panorama of Research on Ectoplasm, which has among its objectives to insert even more research on ectoplasm in the academic environment. This is the result of more than 13 years of laboratory research, field research and several published articles on the subject, including master's thesis and doctoral thesis. "Our intention is to open the doors of universities through the publication of this book," explained Hernande Leite, book organizer and founder of the International Association for Research on Ectoplasm and Paracirurgia (ECTOLAB).

For this purpose all the work was aligned, from the choice of the publisher and the language to disseminate the la-

laboratory research to other researchers, academics and interested parties. "The challenge was to find a unique language for everyone and stay focused," says Ivelise Vicenzi, the organizer of the work. Giuliano Ginani, one of the authors, said that the book is not a finished work and still has much work to contribute.

Hernande explained that the research began in 2006 from the Interassistantial Dynamics of Paracrurgia (DIP), resulting in a work with 7 chapters and written in 6 hands, bringing the most recent research findings on this semiphysical substance and its therapeutic use. Neida Cardozo, author, clarified that since antiquity researchers have realized that in energy there was something more. However, it was not until the 19th century that more rigorous analyzes began, with

with Metapsychic being the precursory science in this area, and now it is Conscientiology. "Our care was to give an interassistantial approach in the use of ectoplasm." concluded Neida

In Chapter VII, Eduardo Azevedo, also author, explains that the doubt of the external viewer loses the rationale when ectoplasm is experi-




enced as a participatory researcher. Ismael Pinheiro Junior wrote a chapter on the Energy System.

Release of the 11th edition of the Treaty Projectiology

Conscientiology publisher, Editares, brings a new edition of the 1st Treatise of Conscientiology, "Projectiology - Panorama of Experiences of the Consciousness Outside the Human Body", by Waldo Vieira (1932-2015).

In its 11th edition, the publication has 1204 pages and 2040 bibliographical references from 37 countries, which seal the serious and scientific study on the phenomenon of projection.



The work brings systematic study of a variety of parapsychic phenomena, analysis of altered states of consciousness, techniques for experiencing out-of-body exit, and applications and benefits from that experience.

The first edition of the treatise was published in 1986 and occupies today the shelves of the main world libraries and has 1907 universal bibliographical references on Projectiology, consolidated as science from the diffusion of this work. Today, internationally recognized as the most important and complete scientific treatise about the experience outside the human body, the work bases the sciences Projectiology and Conscientiology, being the result of more than 3 decades of research of doctor Waldo Vieira.
