

CIs intensify activities abroad

Conscientiological itinerance leaves Brazil, finding ICC volunteers in Brazilian airports are routine and, outside Brazil, are also gaining strength. In more recent international itinerance, there have been book donations in China, book releases, courses, tutorats, commemoration of the first five years of activities of the International Association of Interassistential Parapsychism (ASSIPI) in Portugal, a course in Finland and a schedule for Germany.

Even the press is giving more openness to parapsychism. "Here in Portugal, we've already had radio and newspaper interviews, but on television it's the first time," said Mário Oliveira, who gave an interview with TV RTP Madeira on the Madeira Viva Program on April 23. At the time, he addressed the theme of energy defense. The 38-minute interview resulted in several phone calls to the venue and participants to the event.

In China, on April 29, the volunteer of the International Association of Laboratory Research in Ectoplasmia (ECTOLAB), Ismael Pinheiro Junior, donated the works *Ectoplasm - Contemporary Panorama of Research on Ectoplasm*, of which he is one of the authors, and *Parabrain: New Horizons for Medicine*, of his own, to the department of medicine of the University of Beijing. Ismael, who specializes in traditional Chinese medicine and Western medicine and has been exchanging research between China and Brazil for 12 years, expressed his delight at the receptivity to the works. "Every year I stay in China, I am even more impressed by how much this country has been opening up to new concepts. What was 'unspeakable' in the academy ten years ago, today can be discussed openly, without repression, as concepts of energy and ectoplasm in the Western view," he said.

On May 5, there was a five-year celebration of ASSIPI in Portugal with more assistance. In Madeira Island, the



books *Parapsychic Experiences of a Pediatrician*, Jovilde Montagna, and *Evolutionary Senses and Regressive Counter-senses* by Adriana Lopes, were launched. In the island, there was also the course *40 Energetic Maneuvers*, with 56 participants. Faced with the interest of the students, it was decided to maintain regular activities with volunteers from the island itself.

In Carcavelos, Lisbon, the book *CONS - Understanding Our Evolution*, by Flávio Monteiro and Pedro Marcelino, and the course *Early Parapsychic Awakening* were launched with 31 people present and, between May 7th and May 9th, *Parapsychic Preceptor in Group and Culture of Desso-matology*. The agenda included courses in Porto; *Effects of Energy Interactions*, with 43 participants; *Parapsychical Preceptory in Group and Effects of Forgiveness*, with 85 participants.

Activities in Portugal began in 1994, with a lecture by Dr. Waldo Vieira for

more than 200 people. From 1 to 11 November, ASSIPI, IIPC and UNICIN will be holding a week of activities to celebrate two and a half decades of Conscientiology in Portugal.

The International Association for Existential Inversion (Assinvéxis) held the Practice of Cosmovision at Invexis course from 14 to 17 May in Finland with 42 participants and from 18 to 25 May in England with 53 people, all of whom are Brazilian.

In Germany, on June 22nd and 23rd, the International Association for Existential Programming (APEX) will hold a course entitled *Evolutionary Self-Discernment*, by Laênio Loche in Nuremberg. And between September 27 and October 4, the International Organization of Conscientiotherapy (OIC) will make *Intensive Conscientiotherapeutic Sessions and the Self-Prophylaxis* course through Self-conscientiotherapy in Köln (Cologne).



Conscientiarium will be built on the ARACÊ Campus

ARACÊ volunteers will host the supra-institutional Laboratory Conscientiarium, which provides for 10 days of isolation at Cognópolis Pedra Azul, in Domingos Martins, in the state of Espírito Santo. The proposal was launched in 2014, alluding to the Free Consciousness, sequential scale of Serenism. *"It is one of the legacies of Doctor Waldo Vieira, who encouraged us to build this laboratory, unprecedented and cutting-edge, for the self-conscientiological research. This is an excellent opportunity for those who do not know the Campus ARACÊ to put their brick in the Conscientiarium"*, says volunteer Eliane Stédile.

The initial financial resources will

come from the ECP3 Course, scheduled for January 24, 25 and 26, 2020. In the ECP2 format, the ECP3 is an immersion and energoparapsychic course, allowing the students to recycle intraconsciential, group recyclings and also reurbanization through self-experience of energetic and ideational expansions (mentalsoma). What makes it different is there are no prerequisites.

"All this assistance work is aimed at energetic-orthothosenic support and the maintenance of deintrusion of the conscientiological mega-undertaking, in this case, the building of the Conscientiarium Laboratory at ARACÊ"; clarifies Leonardo Firmato, consciential epicenter of this ECP3.

TV Cognópolis launches video series for conscientiocentric institutions

TV Cognópolis team concluded in May the recordings of the series Specialties of Conscientiology in the institutions of Foz do Iguaçu. The routine of visits and recordings with representatives of CIs began in September 2018 with the objective of presenting the specialty studied and applied in the activities of the 25 conscientiocentric institutions. *"This month of May, it's already the final stretch, we recorded with Interpares and CEAEC. There will be 4 institutions remaining outside of Foz do Iguaçu that will be in stand by, paused for a while, until a CI representative arrives to record"*, explains Emanuel Maia, TV manager.

The main priority of this series project is to form a set of films, a kind of series, for the lay public to understand how neoscience conscientiology works and what are the purpose of the activities that take place within the Cognópolis. For example: the specialties Cognopoliciology,



Experimentology, and Interassistantiology are developed in which institutions and what activities can lay people in Conscientiology participate in? The series of films is available to subscribers of cable TV provider NET Foz and the online public that accesses the Cognópolis TV channel on You Tube.

Veganism or Onivorism? The questioning was the theme of the first Conscientiological Ideagora, an event that took almost a hundred people to participate in the premiere of the debut and another 80 to follow the online transmission. The debate took place on May 13, in the hall adjacent to the CEAEC refectory, and was attended by professors Sophie Bertrand, Roberto Almeida, Antônio Pitaguarí and João Yamasita.

Ideagora's proposal is from the International Association of Existential Programming (APEX) and provides activities every Monday, with the aim of providing information and knowledge generation. *"Life is very complex and with the consciential paradigm we expand this complexity"*, justified in the opening the mediator, Laênio Loche.

Ideagora will have different formations, and the debut was in the 'polemic' mode, in which the four participants were given the orientation to defend different positions in relation to the theme, however without feeding opposition or antagonism.

The second edition, held on May 20, was in the case of Parapsychic Cases, and had reports from Professor Jarbas Paranhos, with the participation of instructors Hernande Leite and Ruy Bueno.



AMAC elects new directors

The Association of Residents of the Cognópolis District (AMAC) held a general meeting, on May 12, and elected a new board of directors that will have Cristiano Berbegier as president, vacant by Marcelo Molinos. Molinos made the accounts for the management from 2017 to 2019 and the vote took place on the criteria of pure democracy, by self-empowerment of candidates through vacant positions.

Among the issues debated, Alexandre Balthazar explained that the perimeter will not pass through Av. Maria Bubiak, but that this avenue will be duplicated and must maintain traffic only of trucks that come from Argentina and Paraguay towards Porto Seco, located in the region

of the airport. The perimeter will pass through Vila Florata and not through the Itaboraí exit, which would be ideal.

It was talked about monitoring cameras integrating the 7 condominiums; students who are afraid to walk in the dark streets at night; some stretches without water piping and the urgency of sidewalks on Maria Bubiak Avenue.

After having written 4 other books, chronicles, opinion articles and letters, most of them published in national press vehicles, such as Folha de São Paulo and Veja, IstoÉ, Época, Carta Capital, Super-Interessante and Galileo magazines, the author presents his new book, this time of autobiographical character.

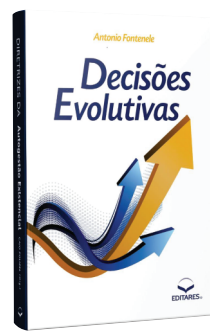
Aiex, who has previously been the president of the Parana Society of Psiquiatria, Municipal Health Secretary and has created the Center for the Defense of Human Rights in Foz do Iguaçu, travels through topics ranging from drugs and chemical dependency to politics, human rights and environment.

In the retrospective of his own life, the author presents certain certainties that have been consolidated over time. In the work, the reader will find an example of self-improvement based on the author's decision for self-knowledge and resignation of life.

Committed to the social well-being, the author transits themes, from drugs and the chemical dependence to politics, human rights and the environment.

Editares also launched the 2nd edition of the *Zephyrus* Book - The Intermittent Parapente by Waldo Vieira, by the author Mabel Teles, and *Zephyrus*, in Ebook version. Also on the Ebook platform were launched the gescons *Consciential Antiwastage - Evolutionary Choice in this Age of Abundance* by author Eliana Manfroi and *My Four Seasons - Towards Conscientiology*, by author Maria Helena Lagrota.

The works available in Ebook versions have the advantages of direct reading in the ebook reader or cell phone, tablet and computer,

On May 28 it was launched the work *Evolutionary Decisions*, by Antonio Fontenele, which brings a crescendo of personal recycling, starting from the pathological approach of decidophobia to the homeostasis of deci-

gaining on average 30% of reading time compared to the physical book. Word looking-up in the dictionary is instantaneous and you can select notes and excerpts from the book and export them to social networks.

Another launch available for acquisition of the physical book anywhere on the planet on Amazon is the work *Self-Derepression - Conscientiological Reflections* by author Rosa Nader. In Print on Demand format, the user buys the book from Amazon's bookstore, which produces it locally and delivers it. In tests in Europe and the United States, the book arrived within 24 hours after ordering.

The 2014 Conscientiology Yearbook, by Flávio Buononato, is another work that has been launched and available for sale, also in Amazon's print on demand version worldwide. The differential is also available for download in .pdf for free on the websites: www.editares.org.br and www.icge.org.br.

And it was necessary to reprint an additional 1,000 units *History of Parapsychism - from Tribal Societies to Conscientiology*, by João Ricardo Schneider.
