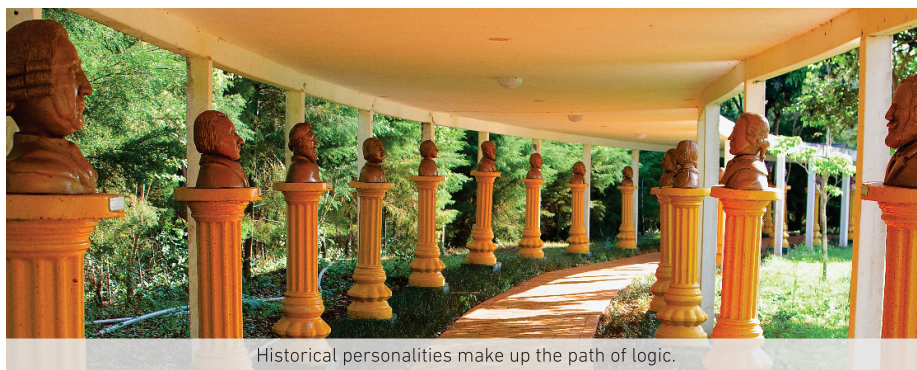

## Geniuses' Alley receives new bust

The electrician engineer, Nikolas Tesla, had a fair homage on June 29th, with the exhibition of his bust on the Human Geniuses' Alley of the Center for Higher Studies of Conscientiology (CEAEC). The proposal was from English teacher Suzi Gussakov, who funded the making of the sculpture.

"In all, there are 174 busts, and the idea is to get to 400 to do all the way around the building", says Dagoberto Cunha, coordinator of the Alley. And the bust-making of the statesman, legislator and Greek poet, Solon of Athens, considered one of the 7 sages of ancient Greece has just been approved.

Until 2015, the names of personalities were approved by Professor Waldo Vieira. Today, a commission, formed by volunteers Cristiano Ferraro, Eliana Manfroi, Ernani Brito, Everton dos Santos, Éverton

Livramento, Fernando Barbaresco, Nara Oliveira, Nilse de Oliveira and Renata Yoki, is responsible for receiving, analyzing and approving proposals for new busts

"The first condition for the inclusion of a bust on the Geniuses' Alley of Humanity is the personality already having desolated or deceased," says Cristiane Ferraro, member of the commission. Another aspect is the positive personal, constructive and cosmoethical example to future generations in any area of knowledge, such as scientificity, pacifism, freedom of expression or contributions in areas of intellectuality, parapsychism and communicability. Among the exclusion criteria are the manifestation of encouragement for warmongering, incitement to human or animal sacrifice and apology for the consumption of alcohol and drugs.

Another factor to consider is the context of the time when the personality lived, explains Cristiane. "The case of

Socrates, for example, who became known as a philosopher, but was also a soldier. However, at that time, it was common for all citizens to be soldiers. So there's no problem with the bust of Socrates going to the Geniuses' Alley of Humanity". Professor Suzi says that the idea of a homage to Tesla occurred during the work of energies in 2014: "I perceived an object that captured the energy of the environment, Suzi found similarity with the Tesla Tower, and the contribution of this genius inventor in the field of electricity, communications and technological advances, such as "Wi-Fi" for example.

The cost of the bust is paid by the person who makes the proposal or by several people who want to help in the expansion of the Alley. Dagoberto also reports that there is a project for the study of personalities with the Association of Existential Programming (APEX), along with CEAEC and other institutions.

### Permanent maintenance

The work of maintenance, restoration and cleaning has been done by Robert Adrian Stephenson, known as Bob, born in 1935 in Essex, England. Belonging to a traditional family of artists, Bob studied zoology, botany and chemistry at London University. He currently resides in Foz do Iguaçu, in a farm near CEAEC, and divides his time between the creation of goats and the making of sculptures at the atelier.

"I prefer to work with clay, because one



of the difficulties is to hit the humidity level. If you get past the point, you can cut the mixture" explains Bob, who bought a special oven and chamber for finishing and painting the pieces in several layers of paint and varnish. Bob's work joins that of the renowned plastic artist Astrid Linsenmayer who had previously sculpted more than 20 busts for the Alley. A few bucks (R\$ 5,00 in the case), typical June food and drinks that each participant takes and the willingness to fraternize. The simple formula has worked well in Arraiá Villa Consciência, the June party that has animated the ICCC every year. In its fifth edition, the party took place on June 15, in the Condominium, and gathered 250 participants, among volunteers, sympathizers and guests.

The party has already consolidated as a fun meeting point and, like the previous year, had impeccable organization, including the characterization of the environment. *"It started with a stall and improvised sound. In that year, we had 5 tents with live music, hot wines, popcorn*

*and the quadrilha"*, says assignee Ricardo Dias.

The purpose, Dias reinforces, is to create space for interaction with possibility of access to all. The initial idea of the party arose in CEAEC, but with the impossibility of accomplishment in Campus, the condominium took the initiative that has already become an 'event'. The event is joint and CEAEC gives all support, especially in infrastructure.

*"The party draws people by its theme and relaxation and is within the purpose of offering more options to bring the ICCC together"*, highlights Dias. In the end, the leftover food was donated to the 'A kick in the future' program, an initiative that helps children through sport, which reinforces the charitable nature of the party.



## At the 11th Meeting of Volunteers IIPC receives terrain for its headquarters

The International Institute of Projectology and Conscientiology (IIPC) held in Foz do Iguaçu, from June 19 to 23, the 11th Meeting of Volunteers. In its eleventh edition (emblematic number), the Volunteer Encounter gathered 159 volunteers from all over Brazil and Argentina and was outstanding for the institution, because the event was formalized by the International Association for the Expansion of Conscientiology (AIEC) for the construction of the Institute's own headquarters.

AIEC coordinator, Cesar Cordioli, along with the coordinator of the Center for Higher Studies of Conscientiology (CEAEC), Fernando Barbaresco, announced the donation during the event. The two coordinators also celebrated, along with the volunteers of the institution, during dinner, held on Friday, 21. The dinner gathered 194 people and was attended by 14 epicons, in addition to the secretary general of the Union of International Conscientiocentric Associations (UNICIN), Polyana Colucci.

## CEAEC invests in the protection and preservation of its collection

This June, the renovation of the roof of the research environment at CEAEC was completed, aiming to protect and preserve the work of the technical teams and maintainers who work in the organization and conservation of more than 950 thousand items of the valuable collections that make up the assets of the International Cosmoethics Conscientiological Community.

*"CEAEC invested more than R\$140.000,00 reais in the renovation of more than 1,300 m<sup>2</sup> of coverage of the Holocycle and Holothecca building, recovery and waterproofing of façades, gutters, rails and insulation with a film made of asphalt and aluminum throughout the roof"* explains Fernando Barbaresco, coordinator of CEAEC.

The improvements are guaranteed for 10 years and reassure the community about the safety of the collection, protecting it from the heavy rains that occur in the region. Such maintenance requires constant attention to mitigate the risks of invasion, fire, water infiltration and moisture, which could cause serious damage to the collection



# Maturity: Assinvéxis completes 15 years

The International Association of Existential Inversion (Assinvéxis) completes, on July 17th, 15 years of foundation with the maturity of who knows that there is still much to do.

To celebrate and expand the range of actions, the 63 volunteers take on the challenge of accessing the generation of young people that circulates on the Internet. *"Intermissivists are not necessarily coming by conventional ways. That is why we have created an area of expansion, aiming to expand the work in social media and in the Campus, to welcome those who arrive"*, emphasizes coordinator Leonardo Bastos, who divides the coordination with Flora Miranda.

In the last 4 years, Assinvéxis has been reinforced by 23 volunteers who moved to Foz do Iguaçu, reinforcing the energies of expansion projects. One of the great investments of the group is the construction of the headquarters, a project that, according to Bastos, has about



50% of its physical structure built.

Currently, the Campus of Assinvéxis counts on the Serenarium, center of support to the laboratory, hall of dynamics, administrative headquarters and a house for 3 residents. The construction of the Technique of Living Alley and Resoma Square are in progress. The next steps are to complete the landscaping and build the Laboratory of Invexology. The project includes a building for pedagogical activities, reception, parking and more laboratories.

Recently, the IC provided a course-trip for Europe, an unprecedented activity called Practice of Cosmovision in Invéxis.

The group of 53 volunteers - mostly for the first time abroad - visited England and Finland, an action that involved educational activities before, during and after the trip. Finland was chosen because of its education and social organization and England, by the historical context, through which it is possible to 'study the world'. The proposal was to exercise the application of the existential inversion, or the challenges imposed by the facilitators and difficulties offered by the intraphysical reality.

As for the next challenges, the coordinator issues direct access to CI. *"We want to make Assinvéxis an attraction, one of the main entrance doors of intermissivists. Our great project will always be to access and receive intermissivists, so they know the technique of the invexis and can execute or streamline their existential programming"*, he emphasizes.

At the anniversary, on July 17th, the CI will hold a dinner at CEAEC, during the Week of the Invéxis (July 11 to 21). Another commemorative activity will be the extension of the Congress of Existential Inversion, normally carried out in 3 days, to 5 days.

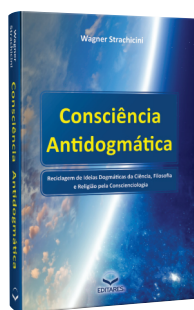
## Launches

On the June 29th, Wagner Strachicini's *Antidogmatic Consciousness: Recycling of Dogmatic Ideas of Science, Philosophy*

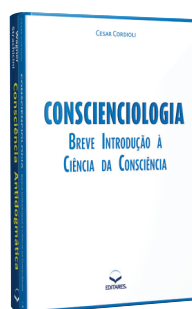

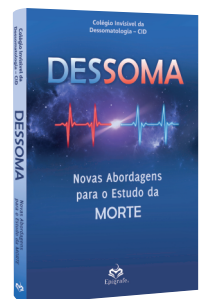


### New Approaches to the Study of Death

is the result of a collective effort of the members and collaborators of the Invisible College of Desomatology (ICD), with the purpose of studying death in its various contexts, especially those related to other dimensions than that of the physical world, in order to clarify the real meaning of death for us, multi-existential and multidimensional consciousnesses speaking.



## HAPPENING

On Thursday, June 13, at 7:00pm, 27 people participated in the new activity initiated at the ICCC: the Verponarium, organized by the International Association for the Expansion of Conscientiology (AIEC). "The goal is to be an incubator of verpons, a space dedicated to knowledge exchange among interested researchers, aiming to increase personal heuristics", explains Cesar Cordioli, creator of this activity. The proposal is to promote monthly debates, always on the second Thursday of each month. It is being done experimentally and the main-

tenance of the activity will depend on participation and interest. The event will not be recorded or transmitted.

Giuliano Branco, coordinator of the UNICIN Intervolunteer Council, informs that the team has been working on the development and reactivation of the Volunteer Reception Service (VRS). The objective is to assist active volunteers, former volunteers or interested parties, whether they are residents or not in Foz do Iguaçu, regarding the specific topic of volunteering in the ICCC.

The Longevus Project is incubated at AIEC, with two work fronts: volunteer Rosa Dias epicenters studies at Invisible College of Longevology, which has 22 members and, in parallel, the project for the construction of the physical structure for the third and fourth age, coordinated by João Colpo. "We are developing similar Census-type research we did last year to see the real size of our audience interested in participating in this venture." Health, architecture, leisure, financial and legal questions should be available in the coming months, clarifies.

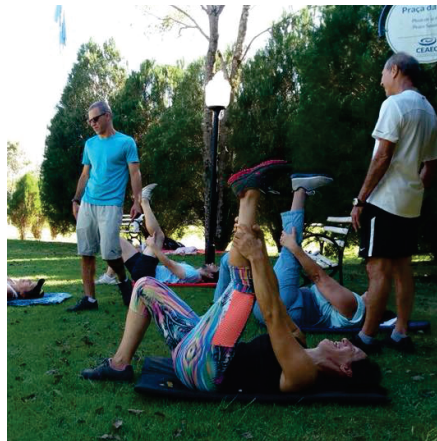
## Hiking and physical exercise at CEAEC

Every Saturday, starting at 8am, a team of 5 Physical Education professionals provides physical exercises for students of the Somatic Self-Awareness Program (PASO). The activities of the first half of 2019 ended in June and, for the second half of the year, they will begin in August.

The program began in 2017 with the objective of diagnosing the physical condition of each participant and generating interaction among professionals and participants about the effects of physical

activity on health and quality of life. After knowing the limits and physical capacities, the person receives information that will contribute to their better auto-



nomny, performance and safety during exercises.

Activities start from 8am at Peace Square or in front of the Village on rainy days. Teenagers from 14 on to seniors can enroll. After registration, physical evaluation and participation in 10 meetings called "big classes" will be scheduled. At the end, physical reassessment is done for control.

The PASO team also walks on Sundays, from 8am on. In 2019, the Bioenergetic Walk and the Walk of Senses were held. The next one will be the Walk of Silence on October 6th. Sign up by the e-mail address:
