

Rosa dos Ventos hosts cognopolis meeting

The II Intercognópolis Meeting, held from June 28 to 30, 2019, at Pre-Cognópolis Rosa dos Ventos, in Natal / RN, was attended by representatives of the 5 Cognópolis. In all, 54 participants attended the event hosted by the International Association of Conscientiology Research Campuses (INTERCAMPI). The first meeting took place in 2017, in Pre-Cognópolis Pedra Azul, Southeast region. By raffle, Cognópolis Foz, in the southern region, will host the third one in 2021.

Cognópolis, City of Knowledge or City of Wisdom, are optimized spaces to anchor suprainstitutional projects, pre-CIs, conscientiocentric institutions and organisms, conscientiological companies, among others. It will be considered a Cognópolis when more than one of these agencies are installed on site. "The II Intercognópolis Meeting was an opportunity to update the conscientiological community about the demands and advances of Cognopolitan projects, as well as to officialize the event as a new instrument to foster intercognopolis interaction, dialogue and partnerships," says Intercampi general coordinator Leonardo Martins .

The hosts organized two exhibitions with artifacts of knowledge: the Intercamp Library, about the history of the Northeast region and the foundation of Intercampi, and the Serenotheca, about serenology. At the end of the activities, they were surprised by a cultural integration dinner, with regional dishes, with lots of shrimp and sun meat, to the sound of *forró* by As Potyguas group.

Representatives

of Cognópolis and the governing bodies of the conscientiological community presented case studies: UNICIN Secretary-General Polyana Colluci gave the conference Cognópolis: Evolutionary Strategy; Alexandre Balthazar and Cristina Arakaki spoke about the role of the College of Conscientiology in face of the Cognópolis and the ICCC; Cesar Cordioli and Everaldo Bergonzini presented the ongoing projects at Cognópolis Foz, with priority for the Cultural Megacenter Holotheca. ARACÊ's general coordinator, Mara Pizzato, and the Cognópolis Pedra Azul commission coordinator, Paulo Moreira, highlighted projects that have evolved since the last meeting, such as Residencial ARACÊ, the Educational and Research Center and the *Conscientiarium* Laboratory.

The Pre-Cognópolis Rosa dos Ventos was presented by the general coordinator, Leonardo Martins, and by the Campus Committee coordinator, Gregório Pinheiro, who highlighted the development from the previous meeting, with the realization of the *Mentalsomatic Parapsychism Dynamics*, the presence of volunteers in more Northeastern states (Maranhão and Alagoas) and the publication of the *Applied*

Mentalsomatology Journal, scheduled for the middle of the second semester of 2019, in addition to the ongoing work of the Campus Committee, such as the search for new terrain.

The coordinator of Campus-IIPC Saquarema, Alberto Paredes, explained the structure of Pre-Cognópolis Saquarema, with emphasis on the *Gesconarium*, *Pacificarium* and 6 laboratories, including the Intermittive Course. At the presentation of Pre-Cognópolis Santa Catarina, the coordinators of *Orthocognitivus*, Aline Bittencourt and Anelise Araújo, recalled that, at the first meeting, the institution was a Pre-CI and is currently a CI with its own physical structure.

Leading the Pre-CI *Planetary Responsibility*, Luciana Ribeiro and Francisco Namiuchi spoke of the *Responsible Cognopolis Program*. Between conferences and debates, Everaldo Bergonzini spoke about Cognopolitan Entrepreneurship, and Roberto Almeida about Scientificity in Cognópolis. Eliane Stédile presented the theme Serenism and Karla Ulman, online, the theme *Democracy in Cognópolis*. *Pro-Cognópolis Interassistential Leadership* was the theme addressed by Fábio Marques and Simone Zolet.

In the end, it was decided to create an Intercognópolis Commission composed of representatives of each Cognopolitan instance in the country, in order to foster interaction between the Cognópolis and Pre-Cognópolis, and also the writing, by Intercampi, of the Letter of Referrals on parageopolitics and good practices for macro work on the planet we are living now.

A significant date of renewals of invesor generations, evolutionary achievements through the application of the Invéxis Technique and the construction and maintenance of the Invexology Campus”, says Marcelo Paskulin, Assinvéxis financial coordinator.

Among the projects under development in the construction of the Campus is the *Life Technique Alley*, an open-air laboratory aimed at providing reflection on life, symbolically representing the 100-year period from birth in Resoma Square to the end of intraphysical life, in Dessoma Square.

The International Association of Pentology (IC TENEPES) held the Penta Dialogues, first in English, in June 2019, in Carcavelos, Portugal, in partnership with the International Association of Interassistential Parapsychism (ASSIPI). In August, it will attend the International Week of Conscientiology, organized by Interassistential Services for the Internationalization of Conscientiology (ISIC), where the second Penta Dialogues will take place in English.

The Penta Dialogues are free public activities that the CI has been holding for two years, always on the last Saturday of each month, at 3p.m. These are discussions without prerequisite, in person

or online, via live streaming on Facebook, about the Personal Energy Task (Penta). The goal is to increasingly interact with people on the theme Penta, in Brazil and abroad, also seeking integration between conscientiocentric institutions (CIs). IIPC also held their first English Live on Saturday, July 20. With the theme Lucid projection and bioenergies, the activity lasted one hour and had the interaction of netizens, who sent questions. Besides talking about the proposed theme, instructors Patricia Barbosa and Andressa Lima called for the International Week, which will be held in Brazil.

A meeting with authors (Book Signing) and an international dinner are the activities scheduled to officially open International Week 2019, an event that will take place from 16 to 25 August at CEAEC.

“Book Signing will be a moment of great celebration for Conscientiology, because, finally, we have a good number of new titles, from several Conscientiology authors, in English”, celebrates the event's coordinator, Liliana Alexandre.

After Book Signing there will be the International Dinner, opening 10 days of intense activities in English, translated into Portuguese. The event is a partnership between CEAEC and Interassistential Services for the Internationalization of Conscientiology.

Liliana points out that only polyglotism will allow the spread of conscientiological verpons worldwide, especially English, the official language in 54 countries and second language in dozens of others.

Uniescon records positive movement of authorship

Courses with full classes and waiting lists for new classes next year. The positive reality reflects the momentum of the International Union of Conscientiology Writers (UNIESCON), an institution formed by authors of conscientiological books in order to encourage new publications, foster exchange among writers and contribute to the qualification of the verpons and works already launched.

With 6 volunteers most involved in the coordination of courses and administrative area and several teacher-authors, the institution has spots sold out for this year and full class booked with waiting list for 2020 in the Authors Training course. The Written-Down Immersion activity, offered every first weekend of the month, also has its full capacity this year, and will open a waiting list for 2020.

Both activities serve one of the pillars of the CI, which is to encourage the formation of new authors. To better play its other pillar, to promote the interaction of those who have already published

work, Uniescon has just launched its first product for early August, the course Megagescon: School of Self-Relay.

"We are in a very cool institutional moment, with high demand and opening new fronts. For the first time, we will offer a course for published authors to help us get to megagescon. It is a very favorable condition", evaluates the general secretary of the IC, Eduardo Martins. The leader also cites the Scriptor journal, a publication that remains for the purpose of scientific dissemination of the conscientiological

authoring.

Martins points out that the positive moment is the result of teamwork, where each project is epicentered by an experienced author, which in itself gathers those interested. But the big attraction, he says, is the CI's strongtrait, the deeper, mentalsomatic self-deintrusion process. *"Professor Waldo has always commented on the importance of the intermissivist prioritizing and publishing the conscientiological book, their gescon. We are following this premise"*, he said.

IIPC: volunteers mobilize from their own headquarters

Volunteers from the International Institute of Projectiology and Conscientiology (IIPC) have already begun mobilizing to build the institution's headquarters following the announcement of land donation by the International Association for the Expansion of Conscientiology (AIEC). The area is approximately 5,500 square meters and is known as the 'fish ground', facing Maria Bubiak Avenue.

Arrangements for the donation of the terrain to the Institute, which has already supported other institutions in building a physical base, began with CEAEC, as the initial proposal was that the headquarters could be built in the Campus area. Immediately, the Projectiology and Reurbex course was established, an event organized by IIPC to raise funds for CEAEC in exchange for the possible donation. The course was also thought to sediment the energies of the new headquarters, since in the projective fields the destination will be the area destined for it.

From then on, CEAEC coordinator

Fernando Barbaresco interceded with AIEC for the donation of the terrain. *"Barbaresco was the headquarters's great supporter, along with Everaldo Bergonzini and Cesar Cordioli,"* acknowledges the coordinator of IIPC Felix Wong. On June 21, during the 11th IIPC Volunteer Meeting, Cordioli announced the donation.

The proposal to carry out Projectiology and Reurbex to raise funds for CEAEC has continued and it has been so successful that the team is considering expanding the number of spots from 150 to 180. Scheduled to take place from 15 to 17 November, the course will have 9 epicons, 5 from IIPC, 3 from CEAEC and 1 from AIEC.

Divided into teams, IIPC Headquarters volunteers are already mobilizing for resources and designing the new headquarters. *"The helpers were more efficient than us. Now we have to do our part"*, says Wong. *"The ideal would be to start with the projectarium"*, says the coordinator.

Psychiatrist and pediatrician, author of the works *Counterpoints of Parapsychism and Evolutionary Intelligence*, Cirleine Couto, received the title of honorary citizen of Foz do Iguaçu in recognition of the volunteer work performed in public health, encompassing acts in the Family Health program and in an entity that works with autism patients. The ceremony took place on June 26, 2019, in the City Council of Foz do Iguaçu, following the proposal of Councilman Marcio Rosa, unanimously approved by the municipal legislature.

On May 23, the International Association for Conscientiological Research (ASSIPEC) announced its withdrawal from the framework of Conscientiocentric Institutions linked to UNICIN and, consequently, from the International Cosmoethical Conscientiological Community (ICCC). This decision occurred after the ASSIPEC general meeting decided not to accept the Opinion No. 59/2019 of the Epicons Council, which directed the deactivation of the APROCIM energy-parapsychic activity, in order to para-safeguard the participants' safety until the institution meets the criteria and structure for the maintenance of this activity.
