15 years of megafraternity challenges

Founded on 01/22/2005, the Union of International Conscientiocentric Institutions celebrates 15 years of group assistance. Unicin's materthosene is mega-fraternity. Better yet, from the megafraternity experienced as Waldo Vieira said in an interview.

Unicin is inspired by the UN model. The search for consensus, dialogue, and deepening issues of group interest are some of the characteristics of the performance of institutional teams.

Unicin's specialties are Conscientiocentrology, Extraphysicology, Paradiplomaciology and Parapoliticology, according to its statutes. In order to grow in these and other areas, the ICCC has the challenge of taking intentions, prescriptions, guidelines, normatives off the paper and bringing everything to the field of fraternal, cosmic experience, through group interassistance. Therefore, Unicin supports the associated Conscientiocentric Organisms and Institutions and their volunteer teams who work diligently in the search for a more inter-cooperative, broad, group and synergistic vision.

In this group objective, Unicin is responsible for helping to resolve and appease the expected differences of intermissivists with varied and complex holobiographies. It is not an easy task, but it is absolutely necessary. It is a commitment to seek to bring out the best of consciousnesses, aiming at the process of planetary reurbanization.

Since 2004, volunteers responded to Professor Waldo Vieira's appeal and played an important role in building Unicin's statute. The first manager was João Aurélio Bonassi when the entire structure and mechanisms were created or started to provide the basis for the institution's growth. It was not an easy task because 2005 was a year in which several CIs were created and this required a lot of work from the

entire team. Then came Maria Izabel Conceição management. It was a time for adjustments, expansion and qualification of the work started by the previous ma-

nagement, because, when we start a bold project such as that of the ICCC. we have to constantly review the processes to keep ourselves aligned with the multidimensional guidelines of the work. Subsequently, Marcelo Silva took over the secretariat, which faced some problems, such as the dissent of a large group of Conscientiology that operated in Europe and was a challenging moment for Unicin. In fact, from the experience we had with facing dissent, the dynamics of Megafraternology was created, under Marcelo Silva's management, which completed five years of operation.

Then, we had the management of Frederico Ganem who faced, in his first year, Waldo Vieira's desoma. This was another moment that moved the community a lot! Despite himself sometimes signaling that this moment of discomfort was close, we had in him a pillar of agglutination and epicentrism of the main questions of conscientiology. In the meantime, one of our volunteers applied for a municipal public office and Frederico Ganem was leaving the secretariat to join this project.

At this time, in September 2015, Marina Thomaz made herself available to assume the secretariat and restructured the Unicin Councils, strengthened the work teams, expanded the interaction with the entire ICCC and resumed the focus on the international performance of the Conscientiocentric Institutions. With my election in 2018, we continued this Unicin group construction and I consider myself, in a way, privileged, because I was able to continue a job built with the effort of many managers and their teams over time. In short, we need to help the conscientiological community to achieve its goals using the tools of intercooperation in order to bring us closer to the experience of mega-fraternity.

Debate on Holomnemonic De-repression marks Consecutivus' 5-year anniversary

In order to celebrate its 5th anniversary, Consecutivus - International Association of Seriexological and Holobiographic Research - brought together volunteers from Conscientiology and researchers from Seriexology, on December 14th, at the Mentalsomatic Circle, to debate the theme Holomnemonic De-repression.

The objective of the debate, explains the institution's coordinator, Dayane Rossa, was to de-dramatize the retrocognitive study as well as to emphasize the application of conscientiological research techniques and methods favorable to the healthy access of memories stored in the parabrain.

"Self-retrocognition must reach the point where the consciousness looks into the past and feels completely good" - this was one of Waldo Vieira's thoughts used in the debate and which resonates with the proposed theme. To exemplify the dedramatization of seriexological research, some volunteers came to the debate



dressed in clothes that referred to certain cultures and times.

With free activities, monthly courses and parapsychic dynamics involving the theme of Seriexology, Consecutivus currently has 47 volunteers in Brazil and abroad, among which there are 40 teachers, 5 epicons and 16 book authors. The institution was founded on December 14, 2014 from the maturation of research carried out by the Technical Team of Seriexologists of the Holocycle, coordinated by Pedro Fernandes.

Gala Night - In order to facilitate the access of researchers to past memories

in a healthy way, Consecutivus will once again hold the Mnemonic Gala Night on June 12th this year.

At this year's event, the ambiance and decoration will be inspired by Ancient Greece. This does not prevent participants from wearing clothes from any era. The important thing is that the person feels good in the costume, prioritizing the positive evocations of the past, explains

Prof^a. Dayane Rossa.

A series of face-to-face and distance learning courses will be offered to connect researchers to seriexological study, in order to facilitate the definition of costumes and deepen self-research.

The II Gala Night will be held at the Hotel Mabu Interludium and there are 100 places available, of which 48 are already filled. The first edition, 6/6/2015, drew the attention of the conscientiological community and brought together 290 participants from Brazil and abroad.

6th Serenology Week happened at Campus Aracê

From 12/27/19 to 2/1/20, the 6th Serenology Week was held at Campus Aracê: a week focused on debate and experiences related to serenism. In total, 35 researchers from 13 cities participated in at least 1 of the 11 activities. The event culminated with the end and beginning of the year, ending 2019 with the Imagistic Test and, in a friendly atmosphere, 22 people enjoyed New Year's Eve in the Espírito Santo mountains.

The Laboratorial Marathon extended throughout the week, with 18 people carrying out 47 experiments in the laboratories. On Saturday, there was the Parapsychic Dynamics of Serenology, with 18 participants. In the afternoon and on Sunday, the 7th Serenology Forum and the 9th Serenauta Meeting took place with 31 people. There were 2 conferences, 3 debate tables with 6 papers and 1 group dynamic.

Monday was dedicated to bioenergetic



activities, each with 13 participants: in the morning, Bioenergetic Tour; in the afternoon, survey of the land where the Conscientiarium Laboratory will be built; at night, the Projective Technique targeted at an interview with a serenissimus.

The new year started with a tourist lunch bringing together 16 people who tasted the beauties of the Cognopolis Pedra Azul region. To close it, on the 2nd there was another Parapsychic Dynamics of Serenology and the Laboratory Debate. Folks came home with the taste of wanting more. And in 2020, we will have more! Schedule to enjoy the new year in the capixaba mountains in the serenism holothosene.

On Saturday, 11/01/2020, synchronous with the number 11, at Cognópolis Foz do Iguaçu, PR, there was a real immersion in 5 events related to: personality of the brilliant French writer Honoré de Balzac; Conscientiology; Parapsychotheca and the Parelencology of the pangraphic novel Cristo Espera por Ti-CEPT (Balzac & Vieira), with which members of the ICCC have a seriexological relationship.


Those responsible for adapting the work CEPT for Comics History (HQ), special guests fulfilling an intense dissemination agenda, were Laudo Ferreira, illustrator and comic artist, twice winner of the 'HQ Mix Trophy' and winner of the 'Angelo Agostini Award' for best designer in 2008 and 2009 and Lilo Parra, nominated as a screenwriter for the 2012 'HQ Mix Trophy' and winner of the award for best original screenplay.

The pre-launch debate in the Mental-somatic Circle opened the script of events on Saturday morning, with the participation of artists in interviews in the Entrelivos Broadcast of Rede Comunicadora Iguassu and in the Grafocons Program of Cognopolis TV. In the afternoon, there was a special edition of the Areópago Conscienciológico with the team of the Collegiate of Conscientiology

addressing the theme 'Parassociology at the ICCC'.

The landmark event took place on Saturday night, with the official launch and autograph night of the 3 works: Charlotte's Passwords, adaptation of the novel Cristo Espera por Ti for the comics, in a numbered edition of 500 copies, especially for collectors: Balzac: Parapsychic writer, original biography focusing on the paraperceptions of the French novelist, precognitor of conscientiology, authored by sociologist Lília Junqueira; and Louis Lambert, with translation and notes by Laurentino Afonso, a novel cited by Waldo Vieira in the treatise Projectiology, as a reference work for bringing the prediction about neuroscience that in the future would study the phenomenon of the consciousness projection.

On Sunday, the Morning Tertúlia pre-





sented by Málu Balona, featured the theme 'Backstage of the book Cristo Espera por Ti' bringing the making off of the Balzac & Vieira / CEP Communication Project (2007-2020). The weekend's cycle of activities ended with the Calepino Conscienciológico, led by Cesar Cordioli, with the theme 'Interconsciential Agglutination - Correlations with the book Cristo Espera por Ti'.

The cognopolis also received the prestigious presence of filmmaker and TV producer Lúcia Novaes, production director for Charlotte's Passwords who, since 2013, received technical consultan-cv in Conscientiology from the Holome-mory of Conscientiology (HLM) team for-med by holomemorialists Ninarosa Man-froi, Málu Balona and Paulo Presse, and the Epígrafe Editora e Livraria team, represented by conscientiology publisher Ernani Brito, responsible for publishing the works under the auspices of Cesar Cordioli, on behalf of the International Association for the Expansion of Conscientiology (AIEC).

Work brings quotes about Cosmoethics

Cosmoethicology is the specialty applied to studies and research on ethics or reflection on cosmic, multidimensional morals, defining consciential holomaturity. Cosmoethicology in 500 citations is the title of the book released in January, written by journalist, lawyer, chronicler and essayist Eucárdio De Rosso. An Editares launch, the book brings an overview

of 'cosmoethics' featuring 500 quotes from the main books written by conscientiological authors and from the entries published in the Encyclopedia of Conscientiology until 2016.



Book exposes the first decade of the Serenarium

In January 2020, an unprecedented work was published on the Serenarium Laboratory, designed by the pangraphy of the physician and independent researcher, Waldo Vieira (1932–2015). Organized by the researchers Ana Seno and Eliane Stédile and produced by the International Association for the Evolution of Consciousness - ARACÊ, the book brings the history of the first decade (2004-2014)

and a series of information about the 1st 72-hour Immersion Laboratory on the planet.

Launched by the International Editares Association, the book is the result of group work, composed of a team of 37 volunteers who dedicated themselves to this project from its conception, through data collection, bibliographic research and statistical survey to writing, and the disposition of contents and images. With a preface by the physician and conscientiotherapist Nario Takimoto and afterword by the researcher Izabel Conceição, the work has 5 sections:

- 1-Serenology;
- 2-Serenariology;
- 3-Laboratoriology;
- 4-Experimentology;
- 5-Research.

On December 4, the CEAEC Holotheca donated 57 titles to compose the collection of the Reading Club Project of the Foz do Iguaçu State Penitentiary, destined for the continuous book collection campaign carried out in 2019 by the Brazilian Bar Association. - OAB, subsection of Foz do Iguaçu, organized by the Commission for the Rights of Children and Youth of the OAB / FI in partnership with the Commission for Women Lawyers and the Commission for Criminal Law.



Held annually since 2011, at the ARACÊ Campus, during the Serenology Week, on 12/31/2019 it was the turn of the 19th Imagery Test, with 13 participants: 9 women, 4 men, 7 for the first time. Proposed to professor Waldo Vieira by serenissimus Australinus, it is the challenge of writing up to 200 definitions, on an object, within 3 hours. After opening the packages with the objects, the participant's surprise: what do I have to do with this object and what do I know about it? During the test the holothosene was extremely mental and so in the end, the exchange of ideas between the participants expanded, showing resulting cognitive gains. The Imagery Test is an activity of the CEAEC Holotheca, coordinated by Professor Nara Oliveira and corrected by an Epicon team.

Pre-IC ISIC volunteers residing in Australia have started the 700 Conscientiology Experiments study group, in English and online, which will take place throughout the year 2020. So far, there are 38 registrants from 11 different countries: Africa, Germany, Aus-



tralia, Brazil, USA, Puerto Rico, Portugal, Romania, Russia, Slovenia and Sweden. Volunteers Tony Musskopf and Ulisses Schlosser held a meeting in January; Ana Paula Firmato and David Lindsay will have their next meeting on February 15th. Registration: bridgebookclub.isicons.org
