ECP3 Pro-laboratory Conscientiarium gathered 119 people

The first month of 2020 ended in an atmosphere of serene conscientiality at Cognopolis Pedra Azul, Aracê Campus, in Domingos Martins, Espírito Santo. The 119 participants, being 102 students and 17 team members from 11 Cls. 10 states and 3 countries, were able to experience an energetic welcoming and fraternity pattern during the ECP3 Course, epicentered by Leonardo Firmato, which took place in Espírito Santo lands, from January 24 to 26. One of the last students to sign up was the manager of the Bristol chain hotel. Artur Caldeira who, understanding the reason for the care of the hotel's environment for the event, ended up joining the class, explained the volunteer coordinator of the field team, Patrícia

The supra-institutional course in favor of projects that integrate the set of conscientiocentric institutions, this time, aimed to support the construction of the Conscientiarium Laboratory idealized by prof. Waldo Vieira, for 10 days of immersion and intraphysical isolation focused on self-research, as reported in issue 223 of this newsletter. "Our efforts started a year earlier with linked information. We presented the laboratory project with the invitation for those who identified with it to participate, being a lever. That made all the difference. People joined and became 'helpers' of the Conscientiarium", said Mara Pizatto, Aracê's general secretary.

Epicentered by volunteers Mara Pizatto, Eliane Stédile and Marco Antonio, this laboratory promotes the integration of the International Association for the Evolution of Consciousness with the International Cosmoethical Conscientiological Community and with the local community in which the Aracê Campus is located, in Domingos Martins / ES.

A curious fact is that the land where the Conscientiarium Laboratory will be built seemed prepared for it a long time ago. "It seems that the land was already



reserved for this laboratory. We only removed some bushes around it, but the central part was flat and without bush" commented volunteer José Antônio. The construction of the Conscientiarium culminates with the moment of expansion in Cognopolis Pedra Azul, which has 8 future projects underway, such as the expansion of classrooms, the construction of an auditorium, space for Cls and volunteer residences, among others, for which the entire conscientiological community is invited to join.

Projects of Cognopolis Pedra Azul

- 1. Conscientiarium Laboratory: project developed and with defined terrain, for the implantation of a conscientiological laboratory aimed at the voluntary immersion of the researcher during 10 days of intraphysical isolation aimed at self-research.
- 2. Condominium ARACÊ: space dedicated to the construction of housing for the lifetime of the volunteer researcher at Cognopolis Pedra Azul.
- **3.** *Pole of CIs:* defined terrain for the installation of administrative headquarters of Conscientiocentric Institutions operating in Cognopolis Pedra Azul.
- 4. Pesquisarium: a defined area for an educational-research complex with classrooms, an auditorium aimed at conducting ICCC field courses, events and scientific production.
- 5. Multicultural Holotheca Center ARACÊ: will

- house a multicultural space open to the community, encompassing the already existing Holotheca on the Campus.
- **6.** Carelogy Project: space for the holosomatic health of the elderly and exchange of knowledge between the young and old.
- 7. Cognopolis in Action Program: implemented program that brings together activities aimed at self-knowledge carried out with the community and local schools: Sapientia Project; Project Changing the World; Life Project; Recreate ES Creativity Workshop; Reading Point; Thematic Lectures.
- 8. Knowledge Route: a project that brings together the local community with the proposal to install environments aimed at spreading knowledge, such as kiosks with busts of geniuses of humanity, books in the 'free-book' system, totems with scientific curiosities installed in several points along the access road to the ARACÊ Campus, legally known as the Knowledge Route.

81 years of environmental preservation of the National Park

The Iguaçu National Park, which connects to the Interludium Extraphysical Community and reurbanizes the region, celebrated 81 years in January 2020. Each year, the number of visits breaks records. In 2019, there were 2 million visitors from 178 countries, resulting in more than ½ of the economy of Foz and the region arising from this tourism. In addition, with the performance of the Carnivores Project, the population of jaguars, a topof-the-chain species, has grown, meaning the generation of life and balance throughout the environment.

This diversity of people linked to the most positive activity, far from smuggling and violence, from an evolutionary point of view, has to do with the process of reurbanisation and holosomatic health, explains the Pre-IC Planetary Responsibility

team, focused on paraecology specialties, conviviology, reurbanology and with the evolutiology materthosene.

Without forests there is no water. Without forest, the falls disappear. With rich biodiversity and rare scenic beauty, the Iguaçu National Park has been recognized since 1986 by the UN as a World Natural Heritage Site. This is the largest biological continuum in the south-central part of the continent. In Japan, the health system literally prescribes 'nature baths' to prevent health problems. Here, tourists do not know, but they feel it in their skin.

And do you, reader, realize the value of these bioenergies? Did you reflect on the deintruding impact of the Park for the Cognopolis? What is your level of empathy with the plants and animals there? Does it connect your own daily actions and thinking with the Park's paraecological homeostasis?

Challenges of the 14th General Examination of Conscientiology

The 14th General Conscientiology Exam held on December 8, 2020 had 102 participants from 13 cities, 11 states in Brazil and 2 countries. There were 53% of gynosomas and 47% of androsomas, making themselves available to the self-cognitive effort to answer 100 questions on the themes of deintrusion, disbelief, paradigmology and pentology.

The GCE is organized by CEAEC with support from Unicin, coordinated by Antonio Pitaguari and has another 4 volunteers composing the team: Pedro Borges, Sônia Batista, Telma Crespo and William Klein.

The highlight was question 70, on the theme of mentalsomatology, with 99 hits, and question 1, helpology, with 88 mistakes. It is also worth the individual effort to answer question 48, on the theme of holosomatology, left blank by 47 people.

That is the question in its entirety, on the theme of holosomatology. Complete the components of the following concepts:



R: body; body and mind; body, mind and brain (DAC, see Triolismology).



Work brings research intertwining lives

Based on the understanding that past life memories make it possible to make more assertive and evolutionary decisions in the present, Giuliana Costa launches the book Autobiography of a consecutive personality: Experiences in Africa according to the Consciential Paradigm. The work brings the author's personal experiences and is based on the hypo-



thesis of cosmoethical infiltration in the African continent.

Valuing detailism and conscientiological techniques for investigating past experiences, the author highlights the importance of personal records in the creation of databases that trigger forgotten memories. The publication of this structured information in self-research led the author to outline the hypothesis of consecutive personality, bringing the work an autobiographical research that intertwines the current and the last intraphysical life.

Double dose affectivity

Conviviality, a backdrop for the evolutionary web of consciousnesses, is the theme of the book launched by authors Everaldo Bergonzini and Lilian Zolet. The work Healthy Conviviality - Conscientiological Reflections on Harmony in Interpersonal Relations is based on the exemplarism of the couple, and addresses aspects related to the circle of friends, family, work and extraphysical companies.





The structuring of conscientiocentric institutions gained fundamental support with the launch of the Manual of Legal Advice in Conscientiocentric Institutions. Designed by Editares Lane Galdino, the work is the result of the author's experience in her work in the IIPC legal department and in the coordination of Unicin's Legal Council, and details the elabo-



ration and maintenance of routine legal procedures specific to non-profit associations.

The manual provides step-by-step instructions on the legal formalities inherent to CIs, as associations in the third sector, and points out the paths to be taken by institutions in all legal operating procedures. With that, it constitutes a prophylactic instrument, insofar as it plans the necessary legal structure for multidimensional voluntary work.

Book approaches VS in a didactic way

Upon learning Conscientiology in 2005, civil engineer Vitor Bolfe made significant changes in his life. And among the main motivations for recycling, Vitor found in the experimentation of the voluntary movement of his own energies, more specifically in the Vibrational State, one of the greatest stimuli.



Just five years after having had contact with the science, Bolfe is exemplary in the publication of his first book Vibrational State - Experience and Self-Qualification, released in January, at the Mabu Interludium Hotel. The book approaches the theme in a technical and didactic way, sharing theoretical and practical information, with the author's narrative about his first experiments and sensations with the basic mobilization of energies.

On February 15 and 16, 2020, the first Assipi event with a prerequisite took place, the unprecedented Lucid Interconsciential Baiting course at the institution's headquarters in Foz do Iguaçu. The 36 participants had the opportu-



nity to try the baits in energy practices, become aware of the predispositions, types of occurrences, their repercussions and what are the benefits of becoming lucid for this reality, avoiding situations of vampirization and daily setbacks promoted by unconscious baits. The objective, according to professor Mário Oliveira, is

to prepare the student to consciously bait an extraphysical consciousness and provide the necessary assistance and referral. On March 14 and 15, 2020 there will be a new edition of this course in São Paulo and soon a new class in Foz do Iguacu.

The International Institute of Projectiology and Conscientiology held, on January 16, 17 and 18, 2020, at the Mabu Interludium Hotel in Foz do Iguaçu, the 5th Teacher Qualification Week, with the theme 'Para-educator: Intermissive Identity'. On the 16th, Professor Málu Balona's conference took place with the theme 'Projectiology: Parapsychic Culture and Scientific Self-Research Parapedagology - a Neoparadigm applied to Self-education', in addition to the celebration of the 32 years of IIPC with the launch of

the campaign for the construction of the Campus, with 94 participants and had its strong point in friendship and intermissive commitment



Epicentrism in Debate is the newest activity in progress at Tertuliarium. Beginning on March 6, the debates will always take place on Fridays, from 9 am to 10:45 am, with the aim of addressing topics related to the development of 'epicentrismology' and 'self-perception'.
