Integrated Actions in the CCCI to face Covid-19

The International Cosmoethical Conscientiological Community paralyzed, on March 12, all the activities of its conscientiocentric institutions, and formed an Integrated Action Commission that decided, with the precious consultancy of volunteers from the health sector, to paralyze all ICCC in-person activities in order to maintain the global quarantine suggested by the World Health Organization and the Brazilian governmental health authorities.

There are a total of 24 institutions that suspended their courses, lectures, parapsychic dynamics, research activities and assistance to a very expressive number of people who seek evolution, self-research, parapsychic development and consciential hygiene.

The short-term result was a drastic decrease in the presence of volunteers and quickly generated a loss of revenue for CIs that are actively working to tackle the crisis: cutting their expenses sharply and preparation to offer the community in time of quarantine online service and courses.

Working groups are currently being constituted to find solutions related to

distance education communication. The Portal of Conscientiology wants to collaborate in this integration of efforts and publicize the actions proposed by the ICCC to overcome this crisis and continue to be interassistantial to everyone. We will open editorial space for full collaboration between all sectors and CI coordinations for the planned dissemination of courses, lectures and events in an online system, including the Cognopolis News which cannot be printed because the printing shop is closed.

This is one of the consequences of living in a globalized world, where the speed with which countries, companies and people transit, producing impressive numbers and statistics. Thus, it was to be expected that, at some point, we would be hit by an equally global health crisis.

As fast as fakes news, the Covid-19 has spread to almost the entire world, causing a forced quarantine unprecedented in human history. Contagion numbers arrive from all corners of the planet, with the exception of Antarctica.

In China, Spain, Italy and the United States, and now in Brazil, the number of people positive for the coronavirus increases exponentially. In forced quaran-

tine, the majority of the population awaits, at home, the outcome of this pandemic. Schools, churches, stadiums, shopping malls, places with large crowds of people are now empty. Along with the health emergency came the beginning of a possible economic recession that was unprecedented, due to the forced shutdown of several productive and service sectors.

According to the Ministry of Health, until March 25, Wednesday, Brazil registered 57 deaths and 2,433 confirmed cases of the disease caused by the coronavirus. On the same date, the world had 416,686 confirmed cases and 18,589 deaths in 197 countries.

Concerned about this undesirable intraphysical scenario, UNICIN, the Collegiate of Conscientiology and the Epicons Council have been meeting daily in search of solutions, consensus and sharing experiences with the objective of articulating aid to our conscientiological community.

We remember our lucid mission to act, in a lucid and cosmoethical way, in the process of extraphysical reurbanization, considering our mini-part condition of a maximechanism of which we are all part.

Change of staff in the coordination of several CIs

Editares, CEAEC and Interpares recently renewed their coordination. Comunicons awaits the return of face-to-face activities to hold the General Meeting and approve the updating of its bylaws.

At Editares, Lane Galdino and Rosane Amadori officially took over on January 1, replacing Guilherme Kunz and Flávio Camargo. The new coordinators created a collegiate of Editors, in which each member becomes a kind of tutor of the book and remains a reference for that work within the publisher. "Our goal is to invest more in publishing books in e-book and print on demand (PoD) modalities, expanding access to the verpons," says Lane Galdino. "We want to make information about the flow of book publishing at Editares more accessible to everyone," says Rosane. In this sense, a folder has also been made available to answer the most frequent questions regarding the publication of works in the publisher.

In the administration of CEAEC there was also a change of staff on January 20.

Fernando Barbaresco passed the position of general secretary to Roberto Leiming. with Janer Vilaça as his vice. "The first challenge is to continue the exemplarism demonstrated in the previous management, under the leadership of Fernando, Roberta and Ricardo. We intend to join efforts to improve the conditions for welcoming the researcher and Conscientiology visitor who finds in CEAEC the largest collection of resources for selfresearch in the current context of the dissemination of the Covid-19 Pandemic, we are mobilizing to offer resources and activities in online and digital mode. Another major challenge is to raise the level of engagement in the Friends of the Encyclopedia Program, the main program for sustaining the scientific production of Conscientiology, which still needs more involvement from the entire ICCC" explains Roberto.

INTERPARES also had a change of coordination on January 20, 2020. Cristiane Ferraro and Ana Luiza Rezende took over the coordination replacing Amin Las-

cani and Roberto Leimig. "What do I expect from INTERPARES' work? To continue the interassistance work, started by Amin and shared with Mabel, to provide scholarships to conscientiology volunteers and students. I feel like giving back the opportunity I had to study abroad with the scholarship I received from CAPES in 2017, and now I help those interested in earning conscientiological scholarships. 'Study: that's all!' pointed out Cristiane.



Reflora Project helps preserve the Tamanduazinho River

On March 3, an action was taken to preserve the Tamanduazinho River in the vicinity of the CEAEC Campus with the planting of approximately 300 native seedlings in the region. It was an action that integrated the CEAEC, the Discernimentum and the International Association for the Expansion of Conscientiology (AIEC) to the Instituto Conhecer para Conservar, marking the beginning of the Reflora Project which has the support of Iguaçu Falls S/A, Marco das 3 Fronteiras, City Hall Foz do Iguaçu and 14th Military Police Battalion.

A tributary of the Tamanduá River, the Tamanduazinho was chosen for feeding about 50% of the water distribution in the municipality. The seedlings planted, such as whip-horse, angico, cedar, ingá, ipepurple, palm-juçara and sangra-d'água, will contribute to conserve the spring and the ecosystem service. Part of them was produced by participants of the 12th Cataract Half Marathon, in 2019.

The Reflora Project is an initiative to enhance the biodiversity of the Instituto

Conhecer para Conservar, born in the Cataratas Group, and aims to strengthen the ideal of tourism and conservation. With the purpose of restoring the urban landscape of Foz do Iguaçu and recovering degraded areas, such as the local

remnants of the Atlantic Forest, through the engagement of society, it works in partnership with public and private entities. Learn more on the Iguaçu Falls channel:

The suspension of face-to-face activities at CEAEC generated a large financial deficit for the CEAEC Campus. Holocycle, Holoteca, Dynamics, Courses, Laboratories, Tertuliarium and Village are without local public. This results in a great loss of revenue and the expenditure containment measures do not compensate for the drastic reduction in revenues.

One way to help at this moment is through the Friends of the Encyclopedia Program, which gives sustainability to the gatherings, laboratories and all the study and research environments of the Campus. The 'friends of the encyclopedia' work in the manner of maintainers of the production of the Encyclopedia of Conscientiology and the daily transmission of Conscientiology Tertulias, transmitted live over the Internet, accessible to volunteers, authors and researchers from around the world.

This program offers advanced research tools like Holoserver and E-Verbetomática. The 'friend of the encyclopedia'

has exclusive access to the 5,158 entries in the Encyclopedia and to more than 40 works on conscientiology, including the Treaties of Waldo Vieira. The novelty is the access to the 3 volumes of the Lexicon of Ortthothoughts, with the last thoughts of Dr. Waldo Vieira.

Brazilian Bibiana Goulart, reresiding in Germany, one of the coordinators of the Reurbex

Group, has just joined the program. "At that moment, due to all this situation, I was able to join because I also want to help. We are very interested in online activities, not only in distance access, but in the entire organized structure of CEAEC, which requires care so that the work continues I am taking a verbetography course for the first time and I won with all the material to which I will have access "comments."

Ligia Decker, also resident in Germany, embraced this campaign by encouraging other researchers. "In times of pan-



demic and social isolation, being 'a friend of the Encyclopedia' is priceless" pointed out Ligia, referring to the research gains with the rich material that the person has at hand, optimizing the use of time even at home, to leverage personal projects and research.

Uniescon's author and volunteer, Marilza Andrade observed that the institution and the various authors could contribute to university research and clarification to the community and organized the donation. "The authors adhered to the idea and Uniescon took over" explained Marilza. "It was a unique moment, full of energy, with the presence of some authors who were able to briefly present their works" explained the coordinator of Uniescon, Eduardo Martins.

The new activity called Epicentrism in Debate, which started in March at CEAEC's Tertuliarium, continues in online format while the restrictions of faceto-face participants last. It was interrupted only on the 13th of March and occurred again online, on Fridays, from 9 am to 10:45 am, coordinated by the Council of Epicons. It began on March 6, epicentered by Ernani Brito, who presented the objectives of bringing topics related to epicentrismology and self-perceptiology to the debate. Ernani addressed the topic of Parapsychic Autonomy. On March 20, Everaldo Bergonzini spoke about Self-paraperceptiothosenity and, on March 27 Roberto Leiming presented Bottleneck of Deperticity. Another activity maintained daily is the Conscientiological Discussions. It has a reduced staff at this moment and without the presence of a public audience. Only the transmission volunteer, the questioner, the local verbetographer and the mediator make the meetings happen. In this moment of intraphysical sanitary isolation, there is an invitation to expand the audience of the Conscientiological Tertulias and reinforce ICCCIs online activity.
