Balance of the first 10 courses of the Integrated Action of the Conscientiological Community

The balance of the first 10 courses of the Integrated Action of the International Cosmoethical Conscientiological Community resulted in reaching an excellent average of 272.7 students per course, exceeding all initial expectations. In all, 2727 students participated in the courses, which took place from March 29 to May 31, of which 240 were from outside Brazil, from over 22 countries, thanks to simultaneous translation into English and Spanish, and in some of them, to German. In addition to Brazil, Portugal was the country that was represented in all courses. Germany, Spain, USA, Finland, Puerto Rico and Switzerland were present in 9 of the ten courses.

Those who followed the article on issue 233 of Cognópolis News, could observe that this unprecedented integration has been happening since the beginning of social isolation actions. A team composed of 20 volunteers from 7 CIs works in an integrated manner in the organization, dissemination and operationalization of distance education courses for the ICC Interassistential Fund. The 24 Conscientiocentric Institutions meet every Monday at the Council of CIs, online, to deliberate on the proposals developed by the Crisis Management Commission. Alexandre Balthazar and Cristina Arakaki, from the Integrated Action team that involves the Collegiate of Conscientiology and Unicin, present the results obtained weekly and put the themes and teachers who self-qualified or were suggested by the CI to vote. The choice is based on the criteria of anchor teachers, veterans in conscientiology, and authors of conscientiological work with a course combined with the theme of their book. 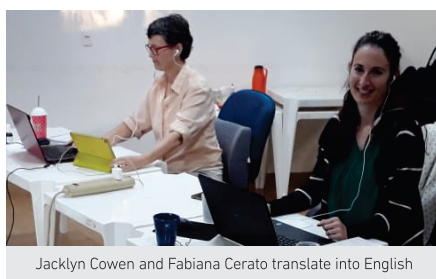

CEAEC took on the epicentrism of these Interassistance Pro-Fund courses and is giving full support to a multidisciplinary team to handle the numerous actions, before, during and after each course.

Although most of the volunteers work in the home office, the complexity of the actions involved, from contact with teachers, creation of a flyer and promotion videos, to the effective registration and closing of the course, makes this work front practically constant. The courses take place on Sundays, but the work takes place daily and, even more intensely, on the weekends by the CEAEC team.

There are also actions planned for the future, such as recording explanatory videos for students to enter the ZOOM room and access slides via link, and also the editing of videos of courses already taken.

Based on these satisfactory results, the intention is to map and invest in professional techniques of attention to the new public and in the survey of the needs of the intermissivist public.

The support, participation and individual and group positioning of Conscientiology volunteers in the dissemination of Integrated Action courses are welcome and will contribute to polykarmic assistance to volunteers, researchers and access to intermissivists.

Thesis on Conscientiology Neologisms

Spanish teacher and translator Luis Ignacio Lopez, born in Córdoba in Argentina and a volunteer at Editares since 1990, defended the theme Projections of the Consciousness: a terminological study of Conscientiology neologisms, at the State University of Western Paraná, Foz do Iguaçu campus, in December 2019, to obtain a degree in Portuguese and Spanish Letters.

The research work consisted of clipping the terms present in the glossary of the work 'Projections of the Consciousness', clarifying the scientific relevance of this terminology due to the particular character of the conscientiological scientific community, based on the Portuguese language. It also aimed at the detailed study of the linguistic bases of the constitution of these terms and the way they are presented in general lexicographic works, such as dictionaries of the Portuguese language and other specialized works.

According to the researcher, the choice of the theme matches his professional work and, mainly, volunteering at Editares. "Through working with translations for over 30 years, I identified the interest in deepening the formation of Conscientiology terms, understanding their nuances and their insertion in general lexicographic works. The presence of the orientating professor Dra. Mariana Girata Francis, for her knowledge of science Conscientiology, made the present work possible," he points out.

Luis says he has more than 300 dictionaries at home. He donated Argentinian newspapers for more than a decade (Clarín, La Nación, Page 12, La Voz Interior de Córdoba, El Tribuno de la Province of Salta), referenced by Professor Waldo Vieira in Treatises 700 Experiments and Reurbanisatus and then by the author's request it become a collection at the Hologycle. With professor Waldo Vieira, he had the privilege of maintaining friendship for 25 years. Currently, he has been working on revising the translation of the work Projections of the Consciousness, into Spanish, and other works, manuals and treatises by the same author are in the queue. The book Projections of the Consciousness is one of the pioneers to publish neologisms, being considered a mini-dictionary of Conscientiology, optimi-



zing the starting point for the study.

Research confirmed the initial hypothesis that Conscientiology terms are constituted, in large part, through semantic transformation (like projection), through umbrella-words (psychosoma), via composition by truncation and agglutination (conscin). In general, it stands out as a process that aims to establish the scientific basis of this Science and its terminological substrate for conscientiology studies.

The study showed that Conscientiology makes linguistic loans with semantic modifications (semantic neologisms) from the areas of knowledge of Biology and Parapsychology such as 'psychosoma', and Mathematics, Biology and Psychology, like 'soma'. Both words are listed in the general dictionaries of the Portuguese language, however, with meanings that differ from those used by conscientiology.

In the view of linguist Maria Aparecida Barbosa, a researcher with rich experience in terminology, lexicography and semantics, this is a process of metaterminologization. There are also loans from the general language that have taken on a new meaning, becoming terms of conscientiology, such as 'psychosoma', a process that this researcher calls terminology. To them are added the processes of formation of new words, like 'conscin' and 'conscix'.

In this way, it is understood that the assimilation of Conscientiology terms by the general dictionaries of Portuguese language should occur gradually, and limited to the terms of greatest evidence in the Conscientiology literature.

It is hoped that this study will serve as a reference for future terminological research and for understanding the formation of neologisms within the scope of scientific activities in any areas of knowledge.

The professors who made up the panel showed interest in this terminology, including one of them with a published dictionary for who wants to know the CEAEC. "For the classmates, the voluntary translation activity I carry out in Conscientiology was a novelty", reveals Luis Ignacio. He says that he took the opportunity to quote the phrase of professor Mário Bunge, given in a lecture at the University of Buenos Aires in 2007: "Tell me how many volunteers a society has and I tell you how advanced it is."

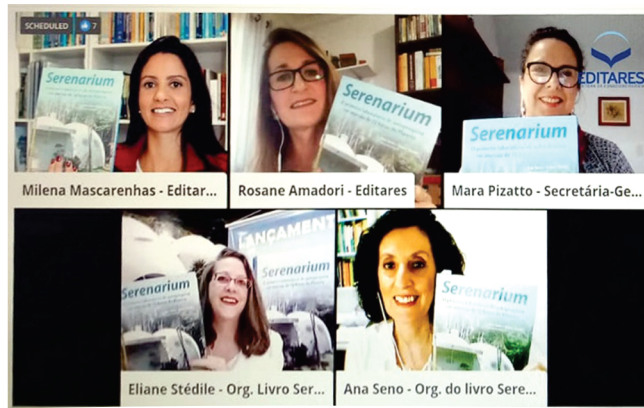


Editares reconfigures website and launches books online

In the moment of social isolation, the publisher of Conscientiology expanded the channel of access to cutting-edge relative truths and launched in the digital age. Editares reformulated its website (editares.org.br), bringing significant changes in content, in particular the expansion of the number of books for download. Now there are 40 works that can be accessed for free, including the 4 treatises on Conscientiology. In addition to the new layout, the site has a structure for displaying the publisher's book portfolio, which today is up 124 works in Portuguese, 17 in English, 11 in Spanish and 1 in German.

Following the movement of publishers around the world, Editares also launched



online, starting with the book *Serenarium*. The work brings an unprecedented study and synthesizes the work of 37 researchers from ARACÊ on the conscientiological laboratory *Serenarium*, the first laboratory of 72 hours of immersion on the Planet. The publisher also launched the sixth edition of the *Interparadigmas Jour-*

nal, the journal of conscientiology specialists who dialogues with other sciences. During the isolation, Editares maintains book publishing activities in the home office model. The Collegiate of Editors meets weekly with the coordination, via virtual platform. "The editing work remains and is even intensified during the quarantine period", highlights coordinator Lane Galdino. "We are looking for new partners to place

Conscientiology works in other showcases", adds coordinator Rosane Amadori.

According to the managers, the absence of face-to-face contact is compensated by the digital platforms, which allow maintaining the synergy of the group's work.

Evolutionary Panel is launched by IIPC

On May 16, a new channel for the dissemination of Conscientiology to the general public was launched, the Evolutionary Panel program, led by journalist Luiz Ribeiro. Using the IIPC YouTube channel, this new interview program is broadcast live directly from Rio de Janeiro every Saturday from 7 pm to 8 pm.

On the Evolutionary Panel, the guests debate current themes from the perspective of Conscientiology with an objective and accessible language, being open to the participation of instructors from other CIs. The program is another consciential gestation of the partnership between IIPC and Luiz Ribeiro, which started in April 2001, maintaining for 17 years the program "Painel Tupi Especial" by Rádio Tupi, broadcast in AM and FM

from Rio de Janeiro. In 2010, the journalist won the Radialists Award for best radio program.

In 2015, Editares launched the book "Conscientiologia é Notícias - A decade and a half of interviews at Super Rádio Tupi", a publication organized by Alessandra Nascimento and Felix Wong, involving several volunteers in the compilation of the interview texts.

Online Self-conscientiotherapeutic Counseling at the OIC

Since March of this year, the International Organization of Conscientiotherapy has directed its efforts towards the development of new online activities, both individual and group, printing interassistential continuity in technical assistance to evolutes.

In the individual modality, the OIC started to offer Self-Conscientiotherapy Counseling online. It is a personalized online interaction with two conscientiotherapists, aiming to promote technical assistance to various intraconsciential demands. The session takes place by meeting (via Zoom platform, up to 1 hour in duration, in Portuguese and also in English, open to anyone interested in deepening their self-research.

Follow the testimony of evolutes after consultation:

"I felt welcomed and understood by the conscientiotherapists. I left the lighter consultancy, with some important issues to work on and with more organized ideas".

"The consultancy was very useful for the elaboration of an evolutionary bottleneck self-overcoming strategy. With the scores of the conscientiotherapists it was

possible to get in touch with the blind spots that caused discomfort in the consciential manifestation".

There are two modalities offered: punctual, characterized by a single meeting, and regular, with weekly meetings at the same time and day of the week. Registration takes place directly at the online store www.oic.org.br/shop. The evolutes' testimonials help to reinforce the effectiveness of conscientiotherapeutic



assistance, even online. However, the institution recalls that this activity does not replace face-to-face assistance.

Various asynchronous and synchronous activities, individually or in groups, have also been carried out. In group activities, for example, the interaction with two conscientiotherapists aims to favor the self-healing movement of the participants in face of specific themes, such as: irritability, fear, anxiety, attachments and losses, existential slump, qualification of penta, emotional wound, insecurity, desoma, self-intrusion and crises, among others. In asynchronous or free activities, several themes are made available through the online platform, in which it is possible to access a series of didactic resources, in form of video classes, study materials, verbetes and self-conscientiotherapeutic sheets.

Free activities also continue, now online. Free lectures take place every two weeks and the OIC Book Club continues, bimonthly, with conscientiotherapeutic analysis and debate about a publication. Live broadcasts are available on the OIC YouTube channel, remaining available for later access:
