Silver Jubilee: CEAEC celebrates 25 years rescuing the holomemory of the Campus

On July 15, the Center for Higher Studies in Conscientiology (CEAEC) completed 25 years of contribution to scientific research on the consciousness. The celebrations of the Silver Jubilee had already begun long before the first half of the anniversary month. Since the beginning of the year, CEAEC volunteers have presented friends, partners, collaborators and visitors of the *Campus* with a series of records that aim to rescue part of the holomemory of this research centre. The pandemic social isolation phase did not prevent celebrations from being held. "We feel challenged to a series of adaptations with regard to the transition from on-site to online planning. The results of group work have been very positive. We are organized so that the celebrations can be extended throughout the year", comments the current CEAEC manager Roberto Leimig who, on the eve of the date that marked the 25th anniversary of the *Campus*, presented the *Morning Tertúlia* entitled *State of Art*. In it, the manager brought up a series of points about CEAEC. "We have a lot to celebrate in these 25 years and this celebration is especially mental-somatic," said Roberto. The general secretary went on to explain: "Many intra and extraphysical consciousnesses helped us to gain the data that we will show below. *The State of Art* is a tradition in Science to present an overview of the productivity of an institution. Anyway, it allows a panorama and a cosmivision of our general production, besides, of course, helping us to identify more clearly the steps that will guide the next 25 years".

In the publication of the *State of Art* seeks to highlight which aspects and dimensions have been emphasized at different times and places, in addition to the forms and conditions by which publications and productions in general have been produced, in order to serve as a source of consistent information and of reference. During the *Tertúlia* (available at



Tertulliarium youtube) it is possible to identify from the scientific publications produced over these 25 years, to the mapping of the biodiversity of the *Campus*.

Proposed by Dr. Waldo Vieira (1932-2015), the CEAEC became the first conscientiological campus dedicated to courses and research in conscientiology. Administered by volunteers, the space stands out for being a cultural and intellectual environment open to the whole community. An important pole of planetary reurbanization, the CEAEC has also gained considerable space in local tourism.

Visitors from different parts of the globe are attracted to the campus environments. One of these places is the *Alley of the Geniuses*, a corridor with 174 busts of personalities from different areas of knowledge that have contributed to humanity, resulting in a true open-air classroom. Spaces such as *Holocycle* (research site where there is a rich collection of dictionaries, newspaper clippings, magazines and encyclopedias), *Holotheca* (an environment that brings together numerous collections of knowledge, including stamps, shells, books, comic books and miniatures) and the *Tertulliarium* (first "debatodrome" of the planet, specially designed and built for the realization of *Conscientiological Tertúlias*) also attract the arrival of interested public to the CEAEC.

For Roberto Leimig, in addition to the structural achievements and conscientious gestation, the celebrations include in a prominent character, the recognition of the city of Foz do Iguaçu and its inhabitants. "Behind the scenes of the construction of CEAEC, there is the valuable contribution of many consciousnesses.

The assistance we have provided over the years has enabled the formation of fertile ground for the construction of the next 25 years. It is an honor for us volunteers to have settled in such a welcoming and cosmopolitan city, as this is how we see our dear Foz do Iguaçu."

With this phrase, the current secretary general of CEAEC Roberto Leimig started the online meeting that marked the celebrations of the 25th anniversary of the Center for High Studies of Conscientiology. Volunteers Izabel Conceição (management 1995-2002), Laênio Loche (management 2002-2005), Hernande Leite (management 2005-2008), Leonardo Firmato (management 2008-2011), Ariberto Metz (representing Phelipe Mansur's management from 2011 to 2014) participated in the virtual meeting, Fernando Barbaresco (2014-2020), Roberto Leimig (current manager), Janer Vilaça (current vice secretary CEAEC), Isabela Collares (CEAEC Communication), Polyana Colucci (representing Unicin) and Moacir Gonçalves (representing the Collegiate of Conscientiology).

In a more informal and relaxed tone, the guests were able to recall through a series of photographic records, remarkable episodes of each management. Volunteer Izabel Conceição (CEAEC's first general secretary), for example, shared some curiosities about the *Campus* implantation phase with her colleagues and the listening public. "Before Professor Waldo Vieira roamed the world after the launch of the *700 Conscientiology Experiments Treaty*, in 94, he handed a paper that he carried in his pocket to the coordinators of GPC Socin (Conscientiological Research Group on Intrapysical Society). On the paper it was written "Center for High Studies of Conscientiology". When handing the notes to the volunteers, Professor Waldo stressed that the beginning of the referred project would be the responsibility of that GPC, who specialized in Intrapysicology", com-

ments Izabel. This was the starting point for a broad research process that gave rise to the configuration of the *Campus* as we know it today. In addition to the many shared curiosities, Izabel Conceição reinforced the uniqueness of the current mo-

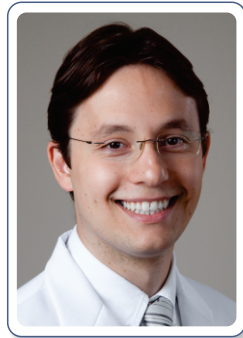

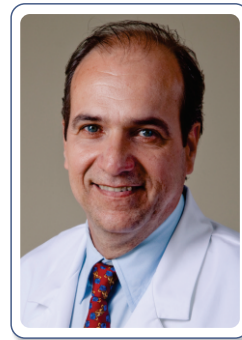
lations", she comments.

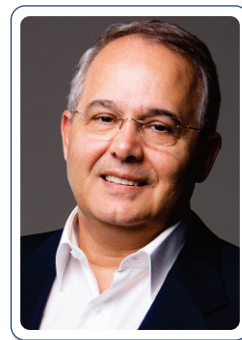

A decade and a half of Comunicons

Comunicons

The International Association for Conscientiological Communication completed a decade and a half of activities on July 24th. In these 15 years, courses, workshops or events were held in Foz do Iguaçu, Porto Alegre, Florianópolis, São Paulo, Rio de Janeiro, Jundiá, Goiânia, Natal, Recife, Salvador and Porto Velho, among other places, with emphasis on the

MediaTraining courses *Conscientiological, Communicometry, Preceptorship in Communicability* and *School of Assistential Evolutionary Scripts - ESCREVA*.

During the anniversary celebrations, an *Ordinary General Assembly* was also held, with the election of volunteer Nerli Vieira to serve as general secretary for the next three years. "One of the goals is to support the volunteers so that they can carry out the projects they are developing, whether they are permanent volunteers or projects. We will invest in partnerships because they add goals and energy and we gain in wholesale assistance", informs the new secretary.

One of the primary objectives of the institution is to continue courses and events aimed at qualifying in Communication for both the public of the Consci-

entiological Community and for new students and communicators in general, clarifying the relevance of the interdimensional communicative process.

"If polykarmality is an institutional challenge, the development of the cosmoethical communicability of the consciousness, a pillar of consciential tridotation, is another challenge for Comunicons", highlights former coordinator Paulo André Norberto. According to Paulo, the lever for access to the billions of Earthlings; the media, the internet and the audiovisual, has been present at Comunicons since 2005. "We debuted with the TV program, *Consciência Livre* and produced radio, newspapers and webTV, always focusing on the quality of the content and form (conform). Comunicons took on the audiovisual challenge with the

production of the documentaries *Parapedagogy* and *Waldo Vieira - Lief and Work*, the children's animation short *O Jardim de Alice* and the audiobooks, in Portuguese and English, *Projections of the Consciousness*", recalls the volunteer.

In 2019, Comunicons entered the audiovisual industry with intensity with the 18-month course of ESCREVA, taking on the

screenwriting studies with great Brazilian specialists such as Lauro César Muniz, Yoya Wursch, Lusa Silvestre and Paulo Cursino, all present at Cognópolis for their masterclasses at Hotel Mabu Interludium.

"Can a film be a megagescon?" Prof. Waldo Vieira's positive answer to the question of volunteer Ana Ceres, author of *Verbet Claritaskal Cinema*, leaves no doubt. Aware of the responsibility of Comunicons with the qualification in conscientiological communicability and recovery of 'cons' (consciential lucidity units) of the intermissivists, the volunteers thank the interassistance of the conscientiocentric institutions and invite the evolutionary entrepreneurs to integrate this polykarmic mission of the expansion of planetary conscientiality.

Author Dayane Rossa launches book Megastrongtrait

A live held on June 20 marked the launch of the work 'Megastrongtrait: study of the greatest consciential talent from the perspective of multiexistentiality', by Consecutivus instructor and coordinator, Dayane Rossa. The broadcast had a special participation by the Consecutivus volunteer Luciana Lavôr who, together with Editares coordinator Rosane Amadori, spoke with the author.

The second work signed individually by the author, the book presents the theoretical foundations of our greatest strong-



trait, its different ways of expression. The didactic style of writing helps the reader to de-dramatize the personal megastrongtrait, to see it in the manifestation itself and, mainly, to take it on avoiding keeping it idle.

The broadcast was marked by dozens of manifestations by Internet users, with questions and congratulations to the author for the publication. In addition to theory, the book provides a technique for identifying the personal strong trait. Dayane Rossa is also the author of the book *Opportunity to Live*, published by Editares, as well as other co-authored works.

Intercampi turned 15 on July 23, 2020

On July 23, 2020, the International Association of Conscientiology Research Campi (Intercampi), completed 15 years of existence. The theme *Mentalsomatic Self-anagement* started commemorative activities that lasted for 7 days, all online, with an emphasis on mentalsomatology.

That festive week's schedule included a presentation of the *Conscientiological Review Workshop - Revcons*, on Friday (24); *Phytoenergies Course: bioenergetic interactions with plants and environments*, on Saturday (25); live of joint celebration between Intercampi and Comunicons, on Sunday (25), since the two institutions completed 15 years in July 2020; special edition of the Laboratory of Applied Mentalsomatics, on Monday (27); first formal debate of the Mentalsomatic Colloquium

among the volunteers, on Tuesday (28); Awareness in Debate program interviewing institutional representatives to talk about Intercampi's 15 years on Wednesday (29) and presentation of Mentalsomatic Reflections Research on Thursday (30).

nardo Martins, estimates that this commemorative week was a milestone for the integration and improvement of the institutional specialty, in the full context of the new coronavirus pandemic and declares that the institution is open to partnerships.

The commemorative activities were appreciated by the institution's volunteers, who add up to approximately 70 intermissivists distributed in 6 different cities. These numbers represent the effort of the institutional team that, since its foundation, in 2005, in Natal/RN, has been expanding its assistance with units in Recife/PE and Fortaleza/CE, since 2008, and has volunteers in João Pessoa/PB, Maceió/AL and São Luís/MA, since 2012, 2015 and 2017, respectively. Assipi reforms activities and expands assistance

The face-to-face restrictions caused by the Covid-19 pandemic resulted in Assipi's reform and the emergence of new activities: *'Parapsychic Chat'* on Tuesdays; *'Parapsychic Encounter'* on Wednesdays; *'Conscientiological Panorama'* and *'Parapsychism in Focus'* on Saturdays, all in the model of distance transmission, through the Assipi channel on Youtube, disseminated and retransmitted by social networks.

This reinvention and adaptation of the old routine, when there was no need for social physical isolation, was essential for the institution to expand its public. Intermissivists who had not yet accessed Conscientiology ideas, are now arriving at online courses and activities. "With the investment in live performance, accesses have grown a lot; each week we have about 50 new subscribers on social networks. They are our intermissive colleagues arriving", adds communication volunteer Luisa Camacho.

An example of this was the Parapsychic Extrapolation course, held on June 13 with professor Mário Oliveira in distance education using the Zoom tool, which had 120 students. In this new course, categories, characteristics and benefits promoted were addressed when



the consciousness exceeds the limits of manifestation of the actual evolutionary level itself and the responsibilities arising from this type of experience.

"I reflected how much we underutilized the assistance potential of our helpers, I realized how to change through our predisposition to meet them and be aware of the multidimensionality and prepare for extrapolations" reported student Romi Schneider. Student Sergio Marcondes also exposed his perception: "I started to see parapsychic extrapolation as an experience showing that we can go beyond the limits established by ourselves. It is multidimensionality challenging us to overcome our comfort zone on the path

of consciential evolution". "It has always been difficult for me to realize that certain inspirations were sponsored by helpers, and the course made me understand and reflect on how to capture the differences between an inspiration and one's own idea, and when these nuances are perceived, it is understood that there is a reason, because the helpers sponsor these phenomena, and invest time and energy, for us to be an interassistential and important channel for everyone", described the student João Saravia.

Pandemic creates opportunity of parareurbanization and recycling

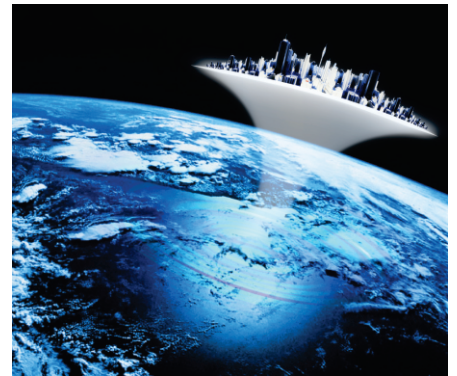
The events that have shaken the world in recent months have brought up numerous discussions, among them, "what will change in the lives of humans that inhabit the planet?" The extension of this discussion, on how these events can contribute to planetary extraphysical reurbanization (reurbex), was the focus of the online event entitled *Parareurbanology e Megarrecins: Case Study of the World Scenario*, of the ICCC Integrated Action, delivered by instructors Alexandre Balthazar and Aline Bittencourt on July 12th.

The study developed by Alexandre and Aline delved deeper into the subject of the covid-19 pandemic and its relationship with extraphysical reurbanization. Among the various hypotheses presented, there is the possibility that humanity is facing a major turning point, a propitious moment for recycling that will be important in the difficult times to come.

There is a great deal of awareness of all the harmful effects that a pandemic like this leaves on humanity, but we have also managed to quantify the positive effects of this chaos, such as a higher

level of global cooperation; union of leaders of religions, with tolerance due to an evil common to all; breath for nature and the planet; more awareness of the way of work versus quality of life; education sector renewal, with technology proving to be efficient; creation of self-sustaining neighborhoods and even a ceasefire between rival global powers. These are undeniable signs that this can be a great turning point.

Among the possible scenarios for the development of this pandemic, there would also be more concern from health systems with a focus on prophylaxis; the readjustment of agglomerations; home office and intelligent and empowered hybrid education; and strengthening global systems of international intercooperation. "It is in this scenario, the 'middle way', that is, the new normal, that we will have more opportunities for recycling, both personal and in group, because the arrival of this pandemic presupposes more group work, in partnership between people and between countries and, most importantly: personal recycling. That indeed, is in the flow of extraphysical reurbaniza-



tion", explains Aline Bittencourt.

For Alexandre, it is important to be aware of our relationship with the history of extraphysical reurbanization. "We were clamped to help with all of this, that is, we need to be aware of this guiding thread that unites us to the polykarmic life programming. To implant a Cognopolis and generate an encyclopedia is to be aligned with this reurbanization, it is to prepare for what will come in the next 50 years. We have a long way ahead of us and the neocognópolis will play a major role in the near future, as will the megarecyclings of each one of us", he concludes.

Integrated Action courses continue on Sundays

The courses on the agenda of the Integrated Action of the International Cosmoethical Conscientiological Community are already part of Sunday afternoons! Those who have followed all the courses say that they bring a considerable contribution to the students. "Sunday afternoons mean more interassistance and interlearning to me. I like to see and hear experienced teachers sharing their theoretical knowledge", says author Ana Seno.

The selection of themes aims to bring content that adds knowledge and contributes to group and polykarmic recycling, like the themes chosen for August: *Consciential Maturity and Evolutionary Leadership* - research by Djalma Fonseca; *Healthy Conviviality* - joint work by Lilian Zolet and Everaldo Bergonzini; *World State: Geopolitics and Interassistance* - research by Gustavo Vieira; *Sense of Gratitude* - related to

the work of Adriana Lopes and *Mapping of Parapsychic and Self-Research Signals* - related to Sandra Tornieri's book.

Very expressive support has been increasing the synergy that favors public access to be clarified by the themes. They are the videos and comments from friends who know the research developed by the course teacher and express support individually, in pairs or groups of volunteers, forming a true social interaction network.

While it is not possible to schedule visits to CEAEC or spend that pleasant season of learning in the study environments, conver-

sations during lunches, cafes or in the gardens of the Conscientiological Campi, the options of the online action agenda of the Integrated Action follows a kind of long term course.

The methodological growth of the VII Parascientific Week

From the 20th to the 26th of July, the VII Parascientific Week took place, totally in the distance format, between 17h to 20h30, during the week, Saturday (morning and afternoon) and Sunday (morning). The difference that added an upgrade in relation to the others was the materthosene "Development of Self-scientificity", maintaining the objective of expanding "Interassistance through interscientific holothosene", informs Alexandre Zaslavsky and Nilse Oliveira, coordinators of the organizing team that counted on the participation of members the Unicin Interscientific Council, highlighting the work of the *Invisible Colleges of Conscientiology* under the coordination of Ana Seno and Roberto Almeida.

"In addition to the quantitative increase, considering the number of participants, we also observed a substantial qualitative increase in the research presented, in the debates and in the interaction between the participants who, in large part, actively contributed by presenting ideas and suggestions", adds Nilse Oliveira.

The growth in methodological research perceived each year is a result of the sustainability that the team has been able to give, like the weekly work meetings that continue even at distance. This



exemplarism has brought new researchers, institutions and conscientiocentric agencies, invisible colleges, among others, to each event.

A highlight was the *IV Forum of Conscientiology Journals*, held on Friday afternoon, with the majority of the editors of the 16 technical-scientific journals of conscientiology active and the presentation by Flavio Buononato and Marcelo Nachbar of a proposal for website implementation integrating conscientiological journals, facilitating access to articles and other published texts.

At the end of the VII Parascientific Week, Unicin released a new project by the Con-

scientiological Research Methodology Working Group to bring to debate the sharing of methods and approaches related to conscientiological self-research, a continuous channel to be enjoyed by volunteers, researchers, teachers and authors of conscientiology.
